

# 4X4 'Professional Off Road Driving Assessment & Correction



<b>Course Objectives:</b>	<p><b>To enable course members to:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be able to carry out a risk assessment</li> <li>• Understand the main principles of driving off-road</li> <li>• Recognise the safe working environment for off-road vehicles on typical ground surface conditions</li> <li>• Be able to assess the suitability of any ground/route, before attempting to drive over it</li> <li>• Prepare and perform the necessary checks to ensure the safety of a vehicle off-road and on-road</li> <li>• Safely operate a vehicle in an off-road situation with a variety of typical ground surface conditions (slopes, Mud, obstacles, water)</li> <li>• Have an understanding of the dangers of vehicle recovery</li> </ul>
<b>Who is the course designed for?</b>	<p>A highly experienced 4X4 driver who requires a nationally recognized certificate as evidence of skills/knowledge. An individual assessment will be carried out and those reaching the required standard will receive the nationally recognised certificate.</p>
