Equipment and Facilities:

- To enable course members to:**
- Identify the risks associated with the use of Pedestrian/Ride-on Mowers
 - Select appropriate Personal Protective Equipment
 - Identify and understand the function of all instruments & controls
 - Carry out daily checks as indicated in the operators manual
 - Carry out pre-start checks
 - Identify and report any faults
 - Adjust the cutting mechanism to achieve the required standard
 - Operate the machine in a safe and competent manner
 - Perform after-use maintenance
 - Understand requirements for traveling on the public road
 - Be able to load and transport the machine (if appropriate)
- Anyone using a pedestrian or ride-on mower as part of their work. This would include novice and experienced operators who require their skills updating, with certification
- Suggest 1 or 2 days depending on experience and equipment used. Extra time (i.e. 1 more day) will be needed where cylinder or mixed machines and or none drivers or complete novices are involved.
- 1:4 with at least 2 machine (one of each type of required cutting mechanism)
